

The essence of A.A. is one alcoholic helping another alcoholic. Jim R. (with permission from Ruth M.)

Hi, my name is Jim R. and I'm and alcoholic. For the past several years I've performed After-Hour Phone duties during the period when the Central Office is closed. Besides the joy of meeting A. A. members, family, and friends, it has provided me the opportunity to practice Patience, Tolerance, Kindness, and Love towards anyone reaching out for help.

The story I'm about to share is from two years ago. On Memorial Day, I received a call from Ruth M. Ruth indicated that a friend of hers suggested she call Central Office to learn how the North County A. A. Groups could help her to stop drinking and get some peace and serenity.

Sometime later as part of my service commitment as a Co-Host on a Saturday hybrid meeting, I granted access to the Zoom Room for a person named Ruth M. Keep in mind I've never seen Ruth, only talked to her on the phone. Ruth sent me a private chat message, asking me if I was the Jim R. that help her on Memorial Day a year earlier. I responded, "OMG Ruth, it's me – So how are you doing?"

Ruth explained she had one year of sobriety and thanked me for helping her. Later in the Saturday meeting format Ruth was asked to share to the Zoom and the in-person members. Ruth stated she has gotten a year of sobriety and thanked Jim R. on Zoom for helping her.


In Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions (Step Twelve, p. 110), we read: "To watch the eyes of men and women open with wonder as they move from darkness into light, to see their lives quickly fill with new purpose and meaning, to see whole families reassembled, to see the alcoholic outcast received back into his community in full citizenship, and above all to watch these people awaken to the presence of a loving God in their lives—these things are the substance of what we receive as we carry A.A.'s message to the next alcoholic."

Since I was the After-Hours Phone Chairperson at the time, I asked Ruth if she would be interested in being a phone volunteer. Within a few days, Ruth responded yes, I'm interested. Later that month she attended a Zoom Learning session on 12-Step Work. 



Ideas for 12 Business Committee regarding surplus of Central Office funds.

- 1. Lower prices of certain books: Big Books, 12 & 12s, etc.
- 2. Purchase x number of Grapevine/La Vina subscriptions for North County physicians, clergy, mental health professionals, or others who come across people with drinking problems.
- 3. Host separate breakfast or lunch events for clergy, lawyers, doctors, military, mental health professionals, police, etc.
- 4. Underwrite the distribution of pertinent literature to school nurses/social workers/teachers, etc.
- 5. Distribute and regularly re-stock pamphlet distribution to non-profit health care clinics throughout North County. This might involve collaboration with the North County Spanish Central Office.
- 6. Contact the North County LGBTQ Center to get on the radar for PRIDE next year. I believe there is also a PRIDE event in Escondido, and possibly in other North County locations.
- 7. Place a communication in the READER, THE PAPER, COASTAL DISPATCH, MILITARY TIMES, and other publications are widely distributed in North County.
- 8. Central office speaker meeting with adjustments to make it more public information focused.
- Meet with NSDYPAA to discuss getting young people involved in 12 step ideas and new ways to reach younger people.
- 10. Workshop to discuss safety in meetings for new members. This includes sexual advances as well as members taking advantage of financial issues of new people. Signs for old-timers notice and intervene.
- 11. Twelfth-Step workshop to have members learn and discuss service opportunities in AA.
